Dinosaur Tag

Put tennis balls (the eggs) inside an empty bucket (the nest).

Two players are the dinosaurs guarding the nest. The rest of the players are the hunters trying to steal the eggs from the nest without getting tagged by the dinosaurs.

Any hunter tagged is out for the remainder of the game.

The dinosaurs win if there is at least one egg left in the nest after 5 minutes.

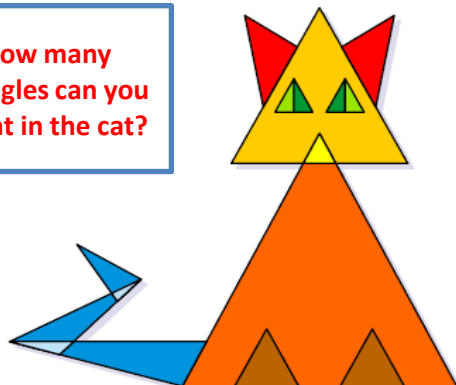

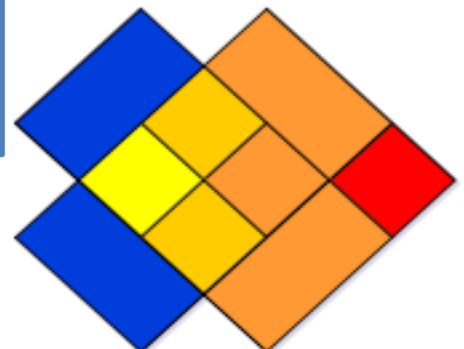
